Workshop	Date	Description
Workshop 1: Find your Passion. Where do you fit in this big world of accounting?	January 21	Manage your career starting now rather than wait until after completion of DAP. Take an inward look, inventory your skills, determine your career goal and begin pursuing it.
Workshop 2: Let's get to work. Best research techniques to scout out your dream job.	January 30	Research is necessary to achieving career success. Identify great techniques, uncover opportunities, and prepare to stand out when competing for positions.
Workshop 3: Be Strategic. Build a plan for moving forward with focus and success.	February 6	Learn how to approach the labour market and your sector with purpose. Realize the significance of the "Hidden Job Market" and gain insights on how to access 80% of employment opportunities with a solid action plan.
Workshop 4: Create a visual brand through your written documents that will be noticed by employers and attract them to want to meet you.
