Ace the Case is a local, national and global business case competition designed to develop your case writing and presentation skills along with giving you the opportunity to build relationships with KPMG professionals early in your career. Ace the Case provides a great opportunity to interact with our people and learn about the cross-functional opportunities available to you at KPMG.

At the local level, our Ace the Case program is run in Vancouver, Calgary, Toronto and Montreal. During the two day workshop and case competition we will teach you how to plan, write, and debrief a business case. Hosted by KPMG professionals, you will be trained by industry leaders on case-writing and presentation skills. The knowledge you'll gain from this workshop will be valuable to you at school, in other business competitions, and later in your professional career. All applications must be received no later than **January 12, 2017 – 11:59PM EST**.

- Cover letter
- Resume
- Electronic copy of your most recent transcript

If you do not have access to an electronic copy of your transcript, we ask that you provide a summary of your marks where indicated
