CPA Recruit

The CPA Recruit is a semi-annual recruitment campaign where national and local CPA firms hire accounting students for full-time, summer internship, or co-op positions in the Spring and Fall each year for positions that generally start in January, May or September the following year. The Business Career Centre, the Diploma in Accounting Program, UBC Accounting Club and UBC DAP Student Club work together to coordinate the CPA Recruit and support you along the way.

The offer acceptance deadlines are also established through the Framework.

What do I need to know about hiring timelines for this year's CPA Recruit?

There will be 2 recruits (Spring and Fall) - the vast majority of recruit for the national firms will be in Spring. Many of the midsize (local) firms will recruit in the Fall.

Hiring timelines are expected to be around the following dates for each cycle (exact dates will vary by participating firm):
